# Türkiye's Most Comprehensive Disaster Management Gathering, NADMEX 2025, Concludes Successfully!

Held with the goal of building a more disaster-resilient society, the **NADMEX 2025 Disaster Management Exhibition & Summit** concluded its three-day program with **12,435 visitors**. Organized by **Sektörel Fuarçılık**, a TG Expo group company, in collaboration with **Yıldız Technical University**, the event brought together public institutions, municipalities, academia, the private sector, non-governmental organizations, and companies operating in the field of disaster management on a single platform.
